**Assignment Title:** Technical Support for providing complete assessment of EEAA existing air quality monitoring networks, and recommendations for establishing, deployment, operation, maintenance of new SLCP/ GHG monitoring network and its integration with the existing EEAA network

The Greater Cairo Air Pollution Management and Climate Change Project aims at reducing air emissions from critical sectors and increase resilience to air pollution in Greater Cairo. The Project aims more specifically at reducing air emissions which is a key step toward the reduction of pollution concentrations and improvement of air quality. The Project will focus on the two main sources of air pollution: open burning of solid waste and vehicle emissions and will geographically cover Greater Cairo (i.e., Cairo, Giza and Qalubiah Governorates -- GC); and will include four main components aiming at: (i) enhancing the air quality decision support system in Egypt; (ii) improving Solid Waste Management services; (iii) reducing air and climate pollutants from vehicle emissions; and (iv) furthering stakeholder engagement, awareness and communication.

This assignment seeks a Consulting Firm to provide support to the Egyptian Environmental Affairs Agency (EEAA) and the cities of Cairo, Giza and Qalubiah to advance existing integrated climate and AQM planning (IC-AQMP) for the tri-city GC area as well as the country of Egypt as a whole, with a specific focus on reviewing existing AQ monitoring systems in GC for criteria air pollutants, GHGs, SLCPs and establishing new monitoring systems to develop a single unified monitoring network that comprehensively covers all three classes of pollution.

The Consulting Firm shall assist EEAA in procuring, deploying, calibrating, operating and maintaining additional instruments for monitoring greenhouse gases (GHGs) and short-lived climate pollutants (SLCPs).

The Consulting Firm will also work with EEAA to establish a data management system to validate and quality assure these data, and incorporate into the larger EEAA data management framework allowing them to jointly address air pollution and climate mitigation in GC and Egypt.
